

Privacy Policy

Aker Ink (“Company”, “we”, “us”) has created this privacy policy in order to demonstrate our commitment to your privacy and inform you about the rights and choices you have with respect to your personal information, how you can assert those rights, and how you can contact us to get answers to your questions. The following discloses our practices regarding personal information collection, use, sharing, and protection of your solely for the website located at akerink.com (the “Website”) and any other services provided by us or our affiliates (collectively, the “Services”).

Personal Information We Collect:

This privacy policy applies to the personal information that we obtain in various contexts. We use the term “personal information” or “personal data” to refer to information that reasonably identifies, relates to, describes, or can be associated with you. Data that has been deidentified or that otherwise cannot reasonably be related back to a specific person is not considered personal information.

We collect personal information that you provide to us directly when you perform actions including, but not limited to, visiting the Website, subscribing to a newsletter, submitting any forms or using any other services provided. The Services may collect your name, email address, website, postal address, telephone number or other information including your resume and associated information.

In addition, the Services may also automatically collect certain personal information, such as IP host address, web pages viewed, browser type, device type, operating system, browsing path, and other data, using technologies such as cookies and other tracking technologies described below in this privacy policy.

Information Usage:

We collect and use personal information for the following purposes:

- To provide our products and Services;
- To communicate with you about our Services;
- For marketing and promotional purposes;
- For analytics and personalization;
- For security and fraud prevention;
- To comply with legal obligations; and
- For any additional purposes that you specifically consent to.

We reserve the right to develop and derive aggregate data (meaning information that relates to a group or category of individuals, from which individual identities have been removed) from personal information in order to enhance and maintain the Services, and such aggregate data will be treated as non-personal information, and may be shared with any number of parties.

Information Sharing:

In addition to using your personal information ourselves for the reasons stated above (and as otherwise mentioned in this privacy policy), we may disclose your personal information to other affiliates and entities in the following instances:

- *Service Providers:* We may share your personal information with third-party service providers who may use your information to provide us with services. These service providers may have access to personal information that is necessary to perform their functions, but they are only permitted to do so in connection with performing services for us. They are not authorized by us to use the information for their own benefit.
- *Business and Advertising Partners:* We may share your personal information with third parties who partner with us to promote products and services, provide marketing and advertisements, conduct data analytics, or use the data for other commercial purposes. We do not control how these third parties use and share your personal information once they receive it. You will need to contact such third parties directly for information about their privacy practices or to exercise any rights you may have (including if you would like to opt-out of marketing messages).
- *Legal Compliance and to Defend Our Rights:* We may disclose personal information and other information as we believe necessary or appropriate: (a) under applicable law, including laws outside your country of residence; (b) to comply with legal process; (c) to respond to requests from public and government authorities including public and government authorities outside your country of residence; (d) to enforce our client agreements; (e) to protect our operations or those of any of our affiliates; (f) to protect our rights, privacy, safety or property, and/or that of our affiliates, you, or others; and (g) to allow us to pursue available remedies or limit the damages that we may sustain.
- *Business Transfers:* We may share your personal information and other information with third parties in connection with a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of the assets of the Company, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which the assets transferred may include information about the users of the Services.

Please note that if you specifically consent to additional uses of your personal information, we may use your personal information in a manner consistent with that consent.

Web Browser Cookies:

“Cookies” are pieces of information used for the purpose of facilitating and enhancing your communication and interaction with a website. Web browsers (or mobile phone browser, tablet browser, etc.) may place cookies on a device for record-keeping or to track certain pieces of

information. Many websites use cookies for these purposes. We may use cookies to customize your visit to the Service and for other purposes to make your visit more convenient or to enable us to enhance our service.

If you would like to stop or restrict the placement of cookies or flush any cookies that may already be on your computer or device, please refer to and adjust your web browser preferences. By deleting our cookies or disabling future cookies, you may not be able to access certain areas or features of our Services or some of its functionality may be affected. Note that cookie-based opt-outs must be performed on each device and browser that you wish to have opted out. Analytics Services:

We may use services such as Google Analytics, a web-based analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). The cookie stores information generated by your use of the Service (including IP address) and is stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google uses this information to evaluate usage of the Service, compiling reports on website activity, and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage. Google may transfer this information to third parties when required to do so by law or when said third parties process certain information on Google's behalf. Clickstream Data:

As you use the Internet, a trail of electronic information is left at each website you visit. We may collect and use clickstream data as a form of aggregate information to anonymously determine how much time visitors spend on each page of our Website, how visitors navigate throughout the Services, and how we may tailor our web pages to better meet the needs of visitors. This information will be used to improve our Services.

Security:

We cannot guarantee that communications between you and Company or information stored on the Service or our servers, will be free from unauthorized access by third parties such as hackers and your use of the Service demonstrates your assumption of this risk. We have put in place reasonable physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard the information we collect. Only those employees who need access to your information in order to perform their duties are authorized to have access to your personal information.

Data Retention:

We will retain your personal information for as long as your inquiry is active or as needed to provide you with the Services, and for a reasonable time thereafter in accordance with our standard procedures or as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, to resolve disputes, and to enforce our agreements. Even if we delete some or all of your information, we may continue to retain and use anonymous or aggregate data, or any other data that constitutes non-personal information. We are not responsible for the data retention practices of any third parties that may process your data on our behalf.

Third Party Websites; Social Media Sites:

The Website contains links to third party websites. We do not have control over any third party websites, and we have not reviewed the content. Interest Based Advertising:
